

**CITY OF EYOTA  
PARK BOARD MINUTES  
March 14, 2018**

**Call to Order:** Chair Schleusner called the meeting to order at 7:11 PM.

**Approve the Agenda:** *There was a motion made by Schleusner and seconded by Kullot to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

**Approve the Minutes:** *There was a motion made by Schleusner and seconded by Horn to approve the minutes of February 21, 2018 meeting. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

**Summer Recreation Program Update:**

Ryan Scheevel gave the park board an updated handout for activities and descriptions that he put together in the summer recreation packet. He stated that he met with city clerk Knowlton and accounting clerk Mierau and we discussed fees, expenses and budget. The packets will be printed tomorrow morning and delivered to the school and handed out to the students on Friday. Summer Recreation registrations will be held Saturday, March 24, and Wednesday, March 28. Scheevel also stated that he would like to give performance reviews to the summer staff this year; possibly one in June and one in July. Discussion was also held regarding assistant directors about giving them more responsibilities and increasing their pay. Committee recommended that Scheevel have a job description and present it at the April meeting.

**Park/Maintenance:**

Kullot stated that the Hiawatha Sno Seekers have a roller they use for their trails. They are willing to let us use it at no cost for the parks. *Motion by Kullot, seconded by Schleusner to recommend this to the city council for approval. All voted in favor. Motion carried.*

**Pick Movies:**

Discussion was held about the movies and dates that were discussed at the February meeting. Eliminate the June 20<sup>th</sup> date. The committee came to a consensus that Jumanji would be shown for sure. Clark suggested doing a poll on Facebook for the other movies. Unanimously agreed.

**Tree Board Advisory Meeting:**

Iris Neumann shared with the committee a billboard of some recent photos of Freedom Park and some future drawings of what kind of tree's she recommends planting; due to the need to replace ash trees. Neumann also had a handout of possible tree selections for Freedom Park along with another handout of trees likely to thrive in our area of the state. She then had the committee vote for which the five recommendations that she had in the number of importance that they would like to see completed first, second, etc.

**Other Business:**

Clark stated that the council did approve the feasibility study for the pool/splashpad.

**Adjourn:** *A motion made by Schleusner and seconded by Kullot to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:20 PM.*
