If there isn't enough room there, we will look at putting it at another park. Zach will come to the meeting in November with some costs.

Dog Park Inquiry: Our Saviors Church pastor had spoken to Mayor Nelson regarding the open space that they have behind the church at 770 Robert Avenue SW. Pastor Volrath asked if the city would be interested in using the space for a dog park. The city would pay for everything including the fencing, all the things inside of the fence like ramps, etc. The city's public works department would have to maintain it, mowing, repairs, etc. Discussion was held and not interested in taking any action at this time.
