PARK BOARD MINUTES
February 13, 2019**

Call to Order: Chair Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Approve the Agenda: *There was a motion made by Kellen and seconded by Heaser to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Approve the Minutes: *There was a motion made by Heaser and seconded by Kellen to approve the minutes of January 9, 2019 meeting. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Park/Maintenance:

- a. Public Works park updates included that the ice rink has been a challenging year trying to keep ice on the rink.
- b. Freedom park handicap accessible updates-City Council approved the purchase of stall dividers, a bucket swing and rubber tiles for the access path to the play equipment. Will be installed by Public Works as soon as the weather permits.
- c. West Side Park wooden train-all sections of the train have been repaired as needed and painted (engine is in the shop right now).
- d. Park spraying is scheduled for as early as possible this spring. Crab grass prevention has been okayed by the City Council as an added part of this year's application.

Dog Waste in Parks: Discussion was held regarding the litter signs & dispensers for West Side Park and the walking trail. *There was a motion made by Robinson and seconded by Kellen to recommend to council to purchase 3 signs and dispensers. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Summer Movie Series: Dates were discussed-June 14, July 16, August 2 & 23; and finalized. Movie titles to be selected at the March meeting. Somehow try to get the word out to see if a group or someone would like to sell concessions on the movie dates.

Other Business: Received a thank you from the resident who wrote the letter regarding the dog litter stations. Secretary Mierau to send it to the board and council.

Adjourn: *A motion made by Heaser and seconded by Kellen to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 PM.*
