Call to Order: Chair Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

First Aid & CPR training will be June 6 or June 7 for staff. Ryan also asked for the assistant coaches to receive an additional \$200.00 each (instead of coming from his salary) and a raise for him. Board to discuss at future meeting. The Park Board would like someone from the Rec program to set up and take down the movie equipment for the four movie nights this summer. The board also said thank you for all you do.


Summer Movie Series: Discussion was held and several movies were mentioned. Secretary Mierau to contact the movie companies to get some prices and will be discussed at the April meeting.
