June 10, 2020

Call to Order: Chair Robinson called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Approve the Agenda: *There was a motion made by Heaser and seconded by Schleusner to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Approve the Minutes: *There was a motion made by Kellen and seconded by Heaser to approve the minutes of May 13, 2020 meeting. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Park/Maintenance:

- a. Public Works park updates: Installed large rip rap on the north side of the 5th St culverts, several trees have been mulched in WSP and Freedom Park, daily sanitizing of park bathrooms continues, mowing continues-some places are being mowed twice a week.
- b. Dog Litter Station on walking path (Knowledge Road): *There was a motion made by Robinson and seconded by Kellen to purchase a doggie station and put near the trail by Knowledge Road in the best location possible. All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*



All voted in favor. The motion was declared carried.*

Other Business: Robinson stated that there are a lot of trees marked in Freedom Park. Robinson to solicit bids to have some taken down.

Ballfields are open-just need to comply with the Covid-19 rules.
